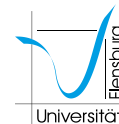
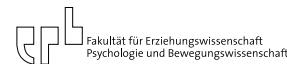
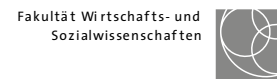

Beside choosing a topic and grounding a research idea in theory research is gathering, analysing, and presenting in scientific contexts to add results to the body of knowledge not only of one's own but also to that of others.

Our workshop tackles these steps of your research project:

- Gathering data via (un)structured interviews and analysing standardized survey data,
- using the computer for content analysis and as a tool for statistics, and
- writing a report and giving presentations.

These steps will strengthen the cooperation in empirical research to boost and streamline one's project.

The regular Workshop Fee is 380 Euro (including meals and accommodation at Sankelmark).
