At our department, we mainly focus on topics related to human resource management, organization and higher education. Methodologically, we apply tools from microeconomics and conduct empirical studies (survey data, archival data, laboratory experiments). As a member of our team you will be committed to high quality research and teaching. You will present your research at international conferences and publish papers (either in single-authorship or written jointly with co-authors) in top-tier international academic journals. Parts of your job will also be dedicated to teaching (German and English). Enthusiasm for teaching is a must.

Being a PhD student, writing a dissertation (either in terms of a monograph or paper based) will be an essential part of your activities. An excellent master's degree or equivalent in business, economics or related areas is a precondition for the position. Previous experience in statistical methods and econometrics is appreciated but not required.
