As it will be conducted in close collaboration with SMEs and industry associations the project offers manifold opportunities to generate unique datasets that allow for empirical studies and respective publications. The project includes independent research work as well as work in a project team involving academics and practitioners.

The ideal candidate holds a graduate degree in Management (or related disciplines), either thinks about entering a PhD program later on or alternatively is a PhD graduate interested in taking the next scholarly career step.
